## NOTICE TO THE BAR MARCH 15, 2024

The United States District Court, District of New Jersey, announced Thursday, March 14, 2024, that Andrea Dechenne Bergman has been selected by the Court's District Judges to be appointed United States Magistrate Judge. Judge Bergman will fill the part-time magistrate judgeship position vacated upon the passing of Magistrate Judge Anthony R. Mautone.

Judge Bergman earned her undergraduate degree from Skidmore College in 1990 and her law degree from Santa Clara University School of Law in 1995.

From 1999 to 2024 Judge Bergman was an Assistant Federal Public Defender for the District of New Jersey. From 1997-1999 Judge Bergman was research and writing attorney at the office of the Federal Public Defender, District of New Jersey. From 1996-1997, Judge Bergman was an Associate Attorney for Victor Rotolo, Esq. From 1990-1992, Judge Bergman was an Intake Paralegal at American Civil Liberties Union of New Jersey.

After an informal swearing in, Judge Bergman will assume her duties effective March 14, 2024. A formal investiture ceremony will be scheduled at a later date.
