
STANDING ORDER 19 - 05

In the District of New Jersey, fees for interpreter services claimed under the Criminal Justice Act shall be paid in accordance with the full day and half day schedules of maximum fees issued by the Director of the Administrative Office pursuant to the Court Interpreters Act, 28 U.S.C. § 1827(b)(3), which can be found at <https://www.uscourts.gov/services-forms/federal-court-interpreters>. For interpreter services paid on an hourly basis, the established fees shall be prorated to an hourly rate, provided that the total amount does not exceed the half day rate for assignments up to and including four hours, or the full day rate for assignments exceeding four hours.

2023 FEES FOR CONTRACT COURT INTERPRETERS

Federal Certified (Spanish, Navaho and Haitian/Creole) only	
Full Day	\$566
Half Day	\$320
Overtime	\$80 per hour or part thereof over 8 hours

Federal Professionally Qualified	
Full Day	\$495
Half Day	\$280
Overtime	\$70 per hour or part thereof after 8 hrs

Federal (Non-Certified) Language Skilled	
Full Day	\$350
Half Day	\$190
Overtime	\$44 per hour or part thereof over 8 hours

Half Day rate is defined as 0 to 4 hours

Full Day rate is defined as exceeding 4 hours up to 8 hours

Overtime is defined as exceeding 8 hours
