
**IN RE: ELECTRONIC SERVICE IN CASES : EXTENSION OF
SEEKING SOCIAL SECURITY REVIEW : STANDING ORDER 2021-09**

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2021, this Court entered Standing Order 2021-09, providing for electronic service and other procedures, in civil actions seeking Social Security review pursuant to § 205(g) of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. § 405(g); and

WHEREAS, the procedures outlined in Standing Order 2021-09 were instituted pursuant to an agreement between the Commissioner of the Social Security Administration (“Commissioner”) and the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey (“United States”), whereby said procedures would remain in place on a pilot basis of one year, or until October 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner and the United States agree to extend the provisions of Standing Order 2021-09 until December 1, 2022;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good cause appearing, **IT IS**, on this **28th** day of **September**, 2022, **ORDERED** that Standing Order 2021-09 is hereby extended, and will expire no later than December 1, 2022, unless extended by further Court order or amendment to Local Civil Rule 9.1.
