This General Order of the District of New Jersey is intended to ensure compliance with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 20(a) for permissive joinder of defendants. Rule 20(a) allows the permissive joinder of defendants where the claims "aris[e] out of the same transaction, occurrence, or series of transactions or occurrences." In this District, in actions where defendants are accused of receiving unauthorized broadcast and satellite transmissions, plaintiffs have typically been joining numerous defendants in a single case where there is no transactional relatedness. This is not permissible under Fed. R. Civ P. 20(a) or any other rule, and shall not be done.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

An attorney filing an action for the unauthorized reception of satellite and broadcast transmissions is obligated to meet the requirements of Rule 20(a) before joining numerous defendants in a single action and shall attest to his or her compliance in a certification accompanying the initial pleading, if more than one defendant is named.
