The United States District Court for the District of New Jersey announces that J. Brendan Day has been selected and appointed as a United States Magistrate Judge. Magistrate Judge Day fills the magistrate judgeship position vacated upon the retirement of Magistrate Judge Lois H. Goodman.

Judge Day earned his undergraduate degree from Dartmouth College in 2005 and his law degree from Seton Hall University School of Law in 2008.

From 2014 to 2020, Judge Day was an Assistant U.S. Attorney in the U.S. Attorney's Office for the District of New Jersey. In 2020, Judge Day became the Attorney-in-Charge of the Trenton Branch Office, and in 2022 became a Deputy Chief of the Criminal Division in Newark. Before joining the U.S. Attorney's Office, Judge Day was a Litigation Associate with the law firm of Sullivan & Cromwell LLP. From 2008 to 2009, Judge Day served as a law clerk to the Honorable Katharine S. Hayden, United States District Judge for the District of New Jersey and from 2009 to 2010, Judge Day served as a law clerk to the Honorable Michael A. Chagares, United States Circuit Judge, United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit.

After an informal swearing-in, Judge Day assumed his duties in the Clarkson S. Fisher United States Courthouse in Trenton, New Jersey effective April 3, 2023. A formal investiture ceremony will be scheduled at a later date.
