

In that pursuant to Rule 32(c)(1)(2)(A) of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure and Title 18, U.S.C., Section 3603, the Probation Office shall provide the Court with sufficient information in order to enable the Court to exercise meaningful sentencing authority, and to aid in the supervision of probationers, it is so ORDERED that the Probation Office is authorized to conduct credit profile inquiries on investigative and supervision cases deemed appropriate by the Probation Office. Said credit profile inquiries shall be conducted in a way pursuant to the requirements of the Right to Financial Privacy Act, Section 1104(a), 12 U.S.C. Section 3404(a).
