: STANDING ORDER 19 – Olo

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice Act Plan for the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey ("the Court's CJA Plan") provides at VIII.C.7.b. there-in that the reimbursement of a Training Panel Attorney ("TPA"/"Mentee"), appointed to assist a CJA Panel Attorney ("Mentor"), may not exceed the compensation maximums provided for "other services" in 18 U.S.C. § 3006A (e)(3) and the CJA Guidelines, Section 310.20, "unless otherwise approved by the district court";

The District Court hereby requires the CJA Panel Mentor to seek authorization from the presiding District Judge that a "TPA" be appointed to assist in their assigned CJA case regardless of the anticipated number of service hours;

THEREFORE, authorization and services up to the compensation maximum will be subject to review and approval by the District Court;

FURTHERMORE, authorization and services in excess of the compensation maximum set forth in § 310.20.10(a) of the CJA Guidelines will be subject to the review and approval of both the District Court and the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit.
