
DOCKETING OF RULE 11 PROCEEDINGS : STANDING ORDER 16 - 1
IN CRIMINAL CASES :

In order to provide public notice of certain anticipated guilty plea hearings, the Clerk's Office will enter on its docket the date and time upon which a defendant is scheduled to enter a plea under Fed. R. Crim. P. 11, unless the Government or the defendant shows good cause why such an entry should not be made in the particular case.

The Court is not required to give public notice of anticipated Rule 11 proceedings when a criminal docket has not yet been created, such as when an unindicted defendant has not yet appeared upon the anticipated charge.
